



IMPORTANT NOTES FOR BOAT YARD USERS

Please read this information in conjunction with the "Lift out & Hardstand Conditions of Use".

- Queenscliff Boatyard hours of operation are **700am-600pm** Monday to Friday and **800am – 500pm** Saturday and Sunday. During periods of reduced daylight (May-August), Boat Owners (and their nominated crew/agent) and External Contractors, will have access to the Boatyard restricted to Daylight hours only.
- Queenscliff Boatyard is in a residential area. All repairs and maintenance work must comply with EPA Guidelines. STRICT noise limitations apply for all work performed on the weekend. (See Conditions of Use – Point 4)
- Only Registered External Contractors are permitted to work at Queenscliff Boatyard. A list of all Registered External Contractors is available from the Boatyard Office. Boat Owners engaging External Contractors who are not registered, must contact the Boat Yard Office, prior to commencing work. Queenscliff Boat Yard reserves the right to deny access to any External Contractor who has not been accepted as a Registered External Contractor. *Registration Packs are available from the Boat Yard Manager.* (Conditions of Use – Point 9)
- All Portable Appliances, Extension Leads, RCD's and Surge Protected Power-Boards **must** be 'Tested and Tagged'. No Double Adaptors are to be used under any circumstance. The Boat Yard manager is able to 'Test and Tag' all electrical equipment. **Charges Apply.**
- The hire of the forklift for use in the yard is charged at \$50 per half hour (minimum charge) and \$25 per 15 mins or part thereof.
- **All sanding and cutting equipment used on these premises must have dust extraction equipment and/or guards fitted.**
- Soda, Grit, Dry and Wet sand blasting will be carried out only at the direction of Queenscliff Boatyard. All requirements imposed by Queenscliff Boatyard and other statutory authorities shall be complied with by the applicant. Any extra costs incurred by Queenscliff Boatyard in administering such work shall be paid for in advance by the applicant.
- Painting of vessels is only permitted on the hardstand. Ground Sheets must be used at all times when scraping or painting. Under no circumstance are paints, solvents or Anti-foul to be poured into the stormwater system. All paints and anti-fouls must be mixed within a contained bund.
- Queenscliff Boatyard provides recycling of Batteries, Waste Oil, Oil Filters, Paper, Metal, Wood and Paint. All trade waste must be placed in the appropriate waste container. All non-recyclable materials are to be placed in the General Waste Containers. Contact Boat Yard Manager for assistance.
- All Spills **MUST** be reported to a Boatyard employee immediately.
- Queenscliff Boatyard does not supply ladders, scaffolding equipment or tools. It is the boat owner's responsibility to supply this. Fall Arrest equipment must be used when working at heights.
- All lift outs must be paid in full prior to the vessel being returned to the water. Please see the office prior to launch time to arrange payment.
- Queenscliff Boatyard operates a small chandlery for the benefit of yard users. A product and price list is attached. If the product you require is not listed, please contact the Boatyard office. It is requested that order forms are received at least 7 days prior to the lift out to ensure product is available.
- Dogs are not permitted in the Boat Yard. Dogs are only permitted along the Boardwalk and Public Access areas and must be kept on a lead and controlled at all times.
